Reading

We will have some favourite stories, rhymes, songs, poems or jingles.

Most of us will be able to repeat words or phrases from familiar stories.

Some of us will show awareness of rhyme and alliteration.

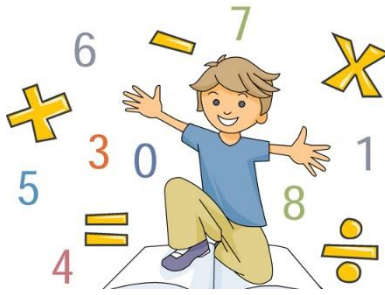


Writing

We will be able to distinguish between the different marks we make.

Most of us will give meanings to marks as we draw and paint

Some of us will ascribe meanings to marks we see in different places.



Mathematics

We will be able to select a small number of objects from a group.

Most of us will be able to recite some number names in sequence.

Some of us will be able to create and experiment with symbols and marks to represent ideas of number.



In addition:

We will be able to sit and listen to stories and most of us will be able to share toys and experiences co-operatively.

Most of us will be able to talk about our feelings with confidence.

In RE we will have an understanding of Jesus as our friend, we will recognise that our name is important to us and that God knows and loves each person by name. We will be able to recognise some religious signs and symbols used in Baptism. We will be able to retell some key events from the Christmas and Easter story.
