Rainbow Fish

The story of Rainbow Fish allows children to consider the feelings of others. How can we be kind to others? How can we share? How can we make others feel happy?

We can look at the differences between others - what makes us different? Our hair colour, our skin colour, the colour of our eyes. These all make us different to one another, even within families.

We are similar to others too. Use the opportunity to talk to your child about how we are all different yet we all have similarities. Talk to them about being different is OK and not something to worry about. Talk to them about just because someone looks different to them it does not mean that we should be worry or that they cannot be our friend.
