

- Following instructions in routines.
- Developing listening skills
- Developing social phrases e.g. 'good morning!'

#### PD

- PE- circle games
- Develop confidence using gross motor skill equipment such as bikes.
- Use tweezers, knives and forks to develop fine motor skills.
- Begin to mark make using a variety of methods.

### All About Me Nursery Autumn Term 2025



#### Maths

- Baseline/getting to know you
- Use number names in play
- Sing and enjoy participating in number songs and rhymes
- Line up and position items
- Notice numbers in the environment
- Notice simple patterns in routines

#### UW

- Talk about members of their immediate family
- Learn about themselves and special things in their own lives.
- Document in a simple age appropriate way, 'maps', models and constructions of landmarks of personal interest.
- Talk about familiar places to them such as the park, shop or the walk to Nursery.

#### Literacy

- Listen and enjoy sharing and joining in with a wide range of books, poems and songs.
- Develop listening and speaking skills in a range of contexts.
- Give meaning to marks they make.
- Marks begin to show variation and form.
- Recognise their name to hang.

#### **EAD**

- Plays alongside other children, showing an interest in those who are exploring new ideas.
- Sing in a group
- Respond through practical exploration how they can manipulate and create effects with various media
